Do Cybernet PCs Support Linux?

With the exception of the iOne-GX31, Cybernet does not offer a LINUX driver set for its products as all testing and development is done with the Windows family of Operating Systems in mind. However, since each product does use industry standard Intel Chipsets, Linux users are able to obtain drivers from Third-Party/Linux websites. One such website is [Linux Graphics Drivers from Intel](#), but we recommend completing a thorough search to ensure the best available drivers are used. Please refer to the model-specific product manual to determine the specific Chipset in use. Cybernet does not provide any direct support for Linux applications and drivers.
